### HWB

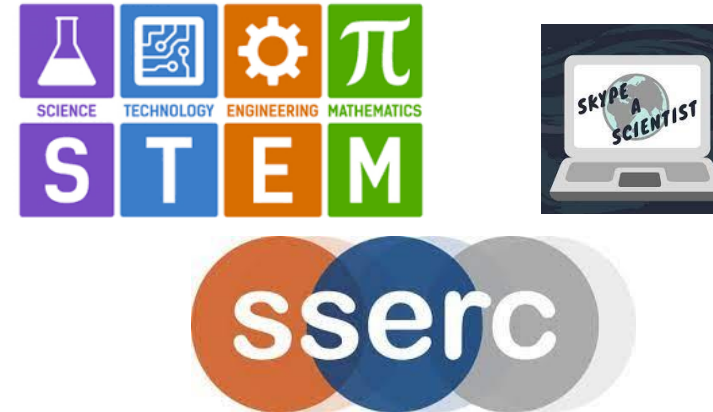
- P.E days are Monday with Mr Sinclair and Friday with Miss Clark, doing hockey and rugby later on in the term.
