## Ethos and life of the school as a community

## Interdisciplinary Learning

The class topic this term is Ancient Greece.

Pupils will be learning about the belief system of the Ancient Greeks. We will be looking at how Ancient Greece shaped parts of Scottish society today as well as comparing and contrasting life of an Ancient Greek with our own. We will look at Greek battles and place them in historical sequence. We will use a range of stimuli, including vases and amphorae, to express ideas in art.

**Maths:** Pupils will learn about percentages and how percentages, decimals and fractions are connected. They will strengthen their understanding of place value and number sequencing. Pupils will revise addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. In addition to this, pupils will learn about analogue and digital clocks and duration of time. They will also revise measurement, including volume and capacity.

**Literacy:** Pupils will continue work on spelling, reading and reading comprehension and personal and functional writing.
